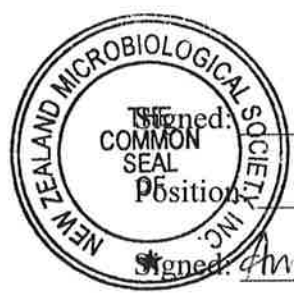
**HOCKEN COLLECTIONS – UARE TAOKA O HAKENA**

**AGREEMENT FOR THE DEPOSIT OF THE ARCHIVES OF THE  
NEW ZEALAND MICROBIOLOGICAL SOCIETY**

1. Ownership of the archives will remain with the Society.
2. The Hocken Collections will abide by any conditions of access agreed with the Society.
3. The archives are accepted on the understanding that they will be deposited in perpetuity and that they will normally be available for public consultation as public funds will be spent on their care and accommodation. In the event that the Society should cease to exist, ownership of the archives will pass to the Hocken Collections.
4. In the event that the Hocken Collections cannot contact the Society after making reasonable efforts to do so, the administration of any conditions of access will be transferred to the Hocken Librarian.
5. The archives will be stored securely in controlled environmental conditions.
6. The Hocken Collections will as resources permit, arrange, describe and preserve the archives according to generally accepted principles of archives management.
7. In exceptional circumstances and for special purposes only loans may be arranged under the terms of the current loans policy.
8. Researchers may only consult the archives in the Hocken Collections' reading rooms and under the supervision of staff.

These conditions may be amended by mutual agreement between the parties concerned.
